HMC Home Health Services

Home Health Services at Hunterdon Medical Center (HMC) provides a comprehensive program of home health care tailored to your special needs. Patients' programs are carefully guided and planned so that care is integrated for maximum benefit. Home Infusion services are also available.

Home Health Services staff include:

- Home Care Nurses
- Physical Therapists
- Speech Therapists
- Occupational Therapists
- Medical Social Workers
- Certified Home Health Aides

They will work with you in collaboration with your physician to find ways to help you feel better, manage your chronic illness, medication, symptom management, exercise, and nutrition. They are your personal "team"!

Hunterdon Hospice

Hunterdon Hospice provides physical, spiritual, psychosocial and bereavement support to those with life-threatening illness and their families. Service focuses on comfort and quality of life. Hospice's unique approach addresses the needs of the entire family unit in planning care.

Extensive adult and youth bereavement support resources are available to the community. Mailings, a Bereavement Library and Speakers Bureau provide information and offer ongoing community-based bereavement services to anyone who has experienced a significant loss.



Hunterdon Lifeline

With Hunterdon Lifeline's **Personal Response System**, help is always close at hand for many of us who may experience health conditions or mobility challenges that threaten our independence.

Lifeline

Our standard service includes your choice of a pendant or wrist-style Help Button. When help is needed, simply push the button at any time.

Lifeline with AutoAlert

In addition to letting you push the button for help at any time, our enhanced service includes a pendant-style button that automatically places a call for help if a fall is detected and you can't push the button.

PMD (Personal Medication Dispenser)

The PMD Service provides an in-home machine that dispenses the proper dose of medication at the right time, reducing the risk of missed or double doses.

The medication dispenser helps to reduce the risk of medical complications, unplanned re-hospitalization and can potentially reduce the risk of falls. The PMD helps you to remain independent in your own home.

Visiting Health and Supportive Services

Visiting Health and Supportive Services provides a range of services which support caregivers and allow the ill and elderly to receive the personalized care they need to remain in their homes.

Certified Home Health Aides perform personal care, meal planning and management, and therapy reinforcement.

NeighborCARE Companions provide support, supervision, and home assistance.

The Statewide Respite Care Program (a state-funded service) supplies Home Health Aides, Companions, adult day care or short-term nursing home placement to allow caregivers a respite from the constant demands of full-time caregiving.

Care Connections, a community nursing service, provides specialized, skilled care to residents of the community in the comfort and security of their own home. Professional nurses perform services such as blood draws, medication dosage pouring, and specimen collection on a prearranged schedule or a one-time basis.
